→ DIVISION DEFINITIONS ←

1. One of the overriding criteria for a correct Division choice is age. Therefore, if you are a 16-yr.-old college freshman, your correct Division would be 0I, not 1. And if you are a 35-yr.-old college sophomore, your correct Division would be either 7 or 8, not 2. Please make sure you put your age on the application so the committee can ascertain if you've chosen the correct Division.
2. Except for Division 0, winners from previous years are automatically advanced to the next Division, unless they request to participate in the same Division for comments only. HS winners will not be advanced beyond Division 0. Winners of Division 10 are automatically advanced to Division 5.

DIVISION	CATEGORY	DETAILS
0	High School	This Division will be divided by age: Younger (13 & 14), Intermediate (15 & 16), Older (17 & 18)
1	College Freshman	Through 20 years old Not more than 1 year of study beyond high school
2	College Sophomore	Through 21 years old Not more than 2 years of study beyond high school
3	College Junior	Through 22 years old Not more than 3 years of study beyond high school
4	College Senior	Through 23 years old Not more than 4 years of study beyond high school
5	Masters Students	Currently pursuing a master's degree program in Voice No Age Limit
6	Doctoral Students – OR – Masters Holders	Currently pursuing a doctoral degree program in Voice – OR – All those holding Masters in Voice degrees No Age Limit
7	Adult Beginner	Less than 2 years of study beyond high school
8	Adult Intermediate	2 – 4 years of study beyond high school
9	Adult Advanced	More than 4 years of study beyond high school Note: This division is for adults who <u>do not have</u> an undergrad degree in voice and are <u>not</u> pursuing a graduate voice degree.
10	Post Advanced	Adults holding undergrad degrees in Voice (not currently enrolled).
